Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc

DESCRIPTION

Wine born from the Banfi adventure in the Bolgheri area.

A vintage with a fairly regular vegetative trend, in which the heavy rains of mid-September were the only critical moment. Thanks to the actions taken in the vineyard and, then, in the cellar, the quality results were excellent.

Complex aromas, characterized by hints of small red fruits accompanied by notes of tobacco and licorice. Soft wine with sweet and elegant tannins, and a long and persistent finish.

Thanks to the good structure and elegance that distinguish it, Aska goes perfectly with game dishes like stewed roe or tortelli with wild boar ragout.

TECHNICAL NOTES



Fermentation: in temperature-controlled (25-28°C) stainless-steel tanks.

Aging: in French oak barriques (225 & 350 l) for about 10 months



Alcohol: 14%



Suggested serving temperature: 16-18°C
